## Trainee Production Coordinator



#### What you will do

As a Trainee Production Coordinator you will be responsible for assisting the Trainee Production Manager in project planning, execution and delivering transmission material for playout. The Trainee Production Coordinator should be aware of all delivery deadlines and keep the team of content producers up-to- date with any changes. You will produce schedules for shoots, pre-edits, edits and audio sessions. You will have the opportunity to set up shoots when required and schedule and manage ordering of materials/resources needed for shoots. You will take part responsibility for budgets, which includes collating relevant statistical data and keep cost and logistics spreadsheets. The Trainee Production Coordinator deals with the overall smooth running of the production office making sure that office equipment i.e. computers, scanners are up and running.

They carry out preliminary telephone and/or face-to- face interviews to assess contributors' potential suitability and availability for inclusion in each video.
